NIGHTLINE





Children and young people work in pairs, with one person guiding the other who can't see through an obstacle course! Great for communication and listening skills.















Our fantastic low ropes course has twelve different activities and is designed for teamwork and listening skills.







COUNTRY TRAIL



The country trail looks at map reading, having fun in the countryside, the country code, walking and wildlife spotting.















ORIENTEERING

Children and young people get to run some energy off around the site against each other, learning about map reading and working together as a team.















HEART START





A brilliant session for young people to learn how to call someone in an emergency, remain calm and understand what to do in a possible emergency situation.









TEAM GAMES



An opportunity to play a variety of fun and challenging team games encouraging children to think, plan, work together and support each other.
