English: The children will be learning to write a non-chronological report to inform primary school aged children about Vikings, their way of life and the impact they had on Britain. We will practice using subheadings to categorise our information into paragraphs, which will be written in a formal and informative tone. For our fictional piece, we will be writing a character description of Grendel – a character from our class book for this half term 'Beowulf'. We will be reading this fanastic text as our class book this half-term.	Maths:In this half term, the children will begin their new topic –shape. In this topic, they will revisit prior learning aroundthe properties of 2D and 3D shapes, learn how to describerotations around a point and also identify different types ofangles.After our shape topic, we will begin to learn about statisticsand will practice interpreting information from a variety ofgraphs. We will then end Year 4 with our Position andDirection topic.	History: Anglo-Saxons and Vikings Our main topic this half term will explore the history of England, focusing on the invasion of the Anglo-Saxons, why they came to settle in Britain and how we know they did. Also, we will be discovering how the country changed when Christianity was introduced and how the Anglo-Saxons managed to resist the invasion of Viking raiders. In addition, the pupils will learn about Alfred the Great and will speculate as to how 'The Dark Ages' earned their name. This knowledge will be demonstrated through the creation of a non-chronological report centred around Anglo-Sxons and Vikings.
Art:In our art topic this half term, we will be exploring craftand design through the fabric of nature. Children will beusing skills such as using natural themes and patternmaking to create their very own fabric design.FrenchThe children will continue to develop theirunderstanding of the French language by learning howto discuss sports, opinions and justifications.	Anglo-Saxons and Vikings	Computing:In computing this half-term, we will be exploring how to use spreadsheets and how this skill can link to everyday life. French: In French this half term, we will be learning how to answer the question 'what is the weather like?' by learning how to discuss the temperature and the clothes suited to particular weather conditions.
RE: This half term, we will continue to explore the 5 Pillarsof Islam, focusing on learning about the pillars of Sawm,Zakaah and Hajj. PE: In PE this half term, Rob Burrow Class will be developingtheir football and athletics skills.Frida Kahlo class will be swimming this half-term, andwill also be developing their skills in athletics.	Science: Electricity In our science topic this half term, the children will be learning about electrical circuits. They will learn which materials are insulators and conductors and how to make simple circuits with switches, they will be able to identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit and identify common appliances that run on electricity.	Music:In music, the children will explore the topic of 'time', in which they will learn how to identify metre in a piece of music, and determine what story the music is trying to tell.PSHE:In our PSHE lessons this half term, we will be focusing on how we manage risks in different places. We will be discussing how to keep safe in the local evironment and less familiar locations, how to keep safe online, how people can be influenced by their peers and the importance of rules and restrictions within our laws and how they keep people safe.
