Writing



Our topic this half term will be 'Childhood' and the children are very excited about this. We will spend the first two weeks writing exciting descriptions for how to make paper dolls and then the remaining four weeks writing exciting adventure stories based on this term's text The Paper Dolls by Julia Donaldson.

Science

As part of our science learning, we will also be exploring our bodies and our senses. We would love it if you could provide a photo of your child from when they were a baby or toddler so we can observe any changes. Photos can be handed directly to us on the door or sent on Class Dojo with your child's name and class clear for us to see please.

Reading

Books will continue to be changed on a weekly basis. Please make sure your child brings in their reading book to school **every day,** as the children will be read with during school time.

Please read with your child at least three times a week and sign their planner. This is now so important as we build up to preparing for the Phonics Screening Check in June.

Maths

In maths, the children will move on to counting in multiples. We will begin by counting in 2s then move on to counting in 10s and 5s. Practising number bonds to 10 and doubles are a really useful way to help your child cement their maths knowledge.

PΕ

PE kits are to be worn all day on PE days only. Check the signs on your child's classroom door to confirm which day your child has PE. Please make sure appropriate trainers are provided if not already in school. If your child attends KS1 dance club it is also important they bring clothes to change into for the club on a Monday.

Homework

You can help by:

At the end of Year 1 children should know all of their Set 1, Set 2 and Set 3 phonics sounds.

Please practise these at home with your child regularly using the video links below or typing Set 1 and 2 or 3 RWI sounds into Youtube. If you need any support accessing this, please consult your child's class teacher.
