Welcome back Little London families,

An amazing first week back at Little London, great to see you all back after a long summer break.

ATTENDANCE

We are really determined to continue improving attendance this year, and to reduce persistent absence.

Remember if you have less than 90% attendance this is classed as persistent absence. If you take time out of school with your children, you may receive a fine of £80 per parent, per child directly from Leeds City Council.

Please keep supporting us by bringing your child every day and on time. Gates open at 8.40am and school starts at 8.50am when the gates are closed and locked.

If you arrive after 9.20am when registers close your child is likely to have an absent mark against the whole morning.

ABSENCES FOR APPOINTMENTS

We do not allow children time out of school for routine check-ups at the dentist or doctors. Please arrange these in either after school or at the weekend/in the holidays. Urgent medical or dentists appointments must get the permission of Mr Done or Mrs Thackray with as much notice as possible, not on the day of the appointment.

UNIFORM

Children have retuned this week looking VERY smart and we would love to keep it that way. Remember, every day of full uniform and/or PE kits can helo your child to achieve 3 star stamps at the end of each week. Remember, other jumpers with the old logo are still available from the school office at a cost of only £5 and we will be selling these for the next few weeks, stock is running out fast! We will also be holding a uniform swap stall in the coming week or so, where families can donate old uniform and we will offer clothing which has been donated and washed and dried to be shared with any family who needs it colmpletely free. Any pre-owned Little London Academy logo garments will be offered for £5. Keep an eye out for the stall, and please remember all black shoes or trainers, all black PE kit without logos and any colour sport trainers.

CHROME BOOKS

We hope, before too long, to open a brand new state of the atr IT suite, so that children can learn how to use a PC not simply a touch screen device or a chromebook. SUMMER FAYRE TOTAL

Office staffing has been affected by sickness this week, but I am sure you will agree that the staff who have stepped in to help Mrs Parchment and Mrs Dugal have been most helpful. We will comntinue to admit children and deal with queries but please remember this is our busiest time of the year so please do be patient.

NURSERY EXPANSION

Thanks to a very generous grant from the Dpeartment for Education, and a very busy summer of contract works, this Autumn we will be able to expand our offer for Nursery to provide a small increase in places, 6 in the morning and six in the afternoon for ages 3+. Unfortunately the 2+ provision we explored was a non starter and would have provided unfair competition to neighbouring nurseries for very few children (very low birth rates in this catchment age) so we had to modify our scope.

EXTENDED LEAVE AND HOLIDAYS

Last August the Government increased the cost of a fixed penalty notice (fine) to £80 per parent per child, which means that if you take a child out of school for more than 4.5 days, Leeds City council will issue a fine to you for £80 for every adult that travels in your holiday party. Please try to arrange visa visits in the holidays, the next holiday is in the last week of October/first week in November.
