They will be learning about how to express their feelings, manage their feelings and how to deal with jealousy.</p>	<p>In our geography lessons this half-term, pupils will be exploring the topic of 'food around the world' alongside their Fairtrade learning theme. In our lessons, we will consider the distribution of the world's biomes and explore the journey our food takes from its origins to our plates. We will also spend time exploring the concept of Fairtrade and why it is important that farmers are paid fairly for their work.</p>
