

| Maths  | Reading  | Writing  | Science  | PSHE  | History/ Geography  |
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| <p>This half term, using White Rose Maths, we will focus on area and multiplication and division. We will also continue to focus on learning all of our times table facts in preparation for our Multiplication Tables Check later in the school year.</p> <p>For the second part of the half-term, we will be focusing on written methods to solve 2-digit and 3-digit multiplication, as well as 2-digits and 1-digit division.</p> | <p>In Reading, we will be reading 'Charlotte's Web'. This story is about a young girl who looks after a little pig called Wilbur. Wilbur befriends a spider named Charlotte. Wilbur's fate means that Charlotte has to find a way to save him. The children will be practicing their inference, retrieval and summarising skills.</p> | <p>In Writing, children will continue learning how to write a recount based on some exciting short films we have watched in class. They will recount the day of a character in the form of a diary entry. Later, the children will learn about how to write portal story, focusing on setting description.</p> | <p>This half term, the children will be learning about animals including humans. They will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Describe the simple functions of the digestive system. They will be able to name the parts and functions of the human organs and have fun seeing what happens to digested food as we recreate the digestive system in the classroom. <p>Identify the different types of teeth in humans. The children will learn about dental hygiene and the names of the teeth.</p> | <p>This half term in PSHE, the children will learn about rights and responsibilities. We will also have a focus on respect and why it is so important in all walks of life.</p> | <p>This half term in history the children will learn about the Roman Empire's impact on Britain. They will also learn about the <i>laws</i>, rules, invasions, and traditions of the Romans. They will use timelines, including the use of AD/BC and will look at key events, in particular, the 3 sieges of Britain.</p> |
| <p>In Computing lessons this half-term, the children will be learning how to code. This will have a focus on debugging and using algorithms to solve a problem.</p> | <p>Our DT topic this half term is textiles. In DT, the children will design and make their own shopping bag. They will be given a design brief, do some market research, plan their own designs, make them, and then evaluate. We will encourage the use of different fastenings and will learn some textile techniques, such as sewing.</p> | <p>In French, Children will be learning about the different sports, as well as revisiting simple greetings. Children will also continue to have weekly Mandarin lessons with a specialist teacher to build their language skills.</p> | <p>This half term in PE, Y4 Marley Dias Class will be swimming once a week on Friday, whilst Y4 Muhammed Ali Class will focus on gymnastics and tennis.</p> | | <p>In Music this half term, In music children will be learning about minimalist music from the 20th century and will be composing their own music based around this. They will also be looking at music from different times in history.</p> |
