### English

### Maths

This term in maths, the children will develop their understanding of numbers up to 50. We will also continue to build addition and subtraction skills using numbers up to 20, supported by pictorial representations and practical resources to help develop confidence and independence.

### General notices

### Reading books

All of the children will have a reading book or a reading sheet, and this will be changed on a weekly basis. Your child's book will be collected every **Thursday**, and a new book will be provided on a **Friday**. Please make sure your child brings in their reading book to school every day as the children will be read with in class.

***Please read with your child at least three times a week and sign your child's planner.***

### PE

PE clothes should be worn on PE days only. Please ensure your child wears a plain black top or hoody and some black bottoms or shorts. Trainers can be worn **ONLY** on PE days. It is important to wear the correct clothing so that your child receives 3 star stamps in their planner each week.

- Practising counting up to 100 in steps of 2, 5 and 10
