<p>This half-term, the children will begin to focus making a whole with tenths and hundredths. We will also learn how to partition, compare and order decimals. Children will then create their own discussive piece on a topic of their own.</p> <p>Our second piece of writing this half-term is a tale of fear. In this topic, we will be learning how to use a discussion toolkit to include speech into their work.</p>	<p>The children will be learning about living things and their habitats this term. We will spend time learning about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The five different animal kingdoms. • Classification keys and how to classify animals. • The impacts humans have on the habitats of living things. 	<p>In PSHE, children will be learning about their changing bodies and puberty. We will discuss how their bodies grow and change.</p>	<p>In our geography lessons this half-term, pupils will be exploring the topic of ‘Mountains: The Alps’. Children will consider the climate of mountain ranges and investigate the human and physical features that attract tourists to an Alpine region (Innsbruck) and compare to tourism in the local area by mapping recreational land use.</p>
