We hope you have had a wonderful and restful break. We are extremely excited to welcome back all of the children and begin the fun of this half term. They have all been working very hard and we are very proud of all the progress they have made so far! Well done Friendly Foxes!

This half term our theme is Fun on the farm; the children will explore and learn all about life on the farm and the animals that live there. They will learn key facts and knowledge about where our food comes from and build a new set of vocabulary to support this, honing their oracy skills along the way. The children will explore different textures and materials used to build sturdy barns and fences, the different types of media we can use to recreate the patterns of animal coats, as well as exploring farm life through key texts. We are looking forward to deepening their understanding of the natural world and the hardworking environment of the farm



To support our learning, we will be reading a range of books such as, 'Busy Farm' and "A Squash and A Squeeze". We will also have books within our exploration area for the children to explore.

**Reading & Phonics:**

The children will continue to learn about rhyme, rhythm and sounds, through Phase 1 phonics. Creating an exciting start to their Phonics journey at Little London.

We will begin with a non-fiction text, 'Busy Farm', to explore life on the farm and discover what lies beyond the fields. This will then lead into learning and exploration, where the children will have the opportunity to build their own barns and problem solve how to catch the farm animals.

**Maths:**

The children will continue to develop confidence and independence in number through revisiting counting and subitising. They will develop their knowledge of composition by recognising numbers in different arrangements and explaining how they know how many there are, for example, "I know it's 3 because I can see 2 on the top and 1 on the bottom." The children will also continue to practise using counting rules to help them count accurately and independently.



At Little London we use Tapestry and Class Dojo to share your child's learning with you. We also post some helpful videos and messages that will support your child with their learning at home. Don't forget to 'like' the posts we share with you to help us see you have read it!

Please can we remind you to log into these apps regularly to keep up to date with what your child is doing at school. If you need any support doing this, please speak to your class teacher.
