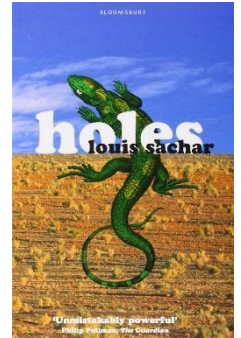

Hello!

Welcome back to Year 6's final term in primary school! We hope you all had a lovely break and are ready for another busy term. Thank you for all your support last half term. The children completed their SATs assessments just before the holidays and worked exceptionally hard. We are so proud of them.

Our new topic this half term will be 'Energy' and we will be reading 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. We will also be completing a 'Deep Curriculum Analysis' project. The topic will be about 'Guernica', a painting by Picasso. They will learn about the painting and the Spanish civil war. PE days will be on Monday for all children, including swimming for those who have had letters, and Wednesday. This term the children will also have the opportunity to do transition days at their new schools. Many of the schools will also come to visit the children here to get to know them and make the transition easier.



**Writing:**

We will be writing a setting description based on a portal story using 'Talk for Writing' structure to our lessons.

**Maths:**

In maths, we will be moving on to do real world challenges, puzzles and mathematical problem solving.

**Reading:**

All children will have their own reading book chosen at their reading level. We would like you to send your child to school each day with it, along with their reading record.
