<p>This half term, we will be learning about place value within 100, building our understanding of numbers by recognising, comparing, ordering, and partitioning tens and ones. We will also practise adding and subtracting using number lines.</p> <p>We will explore comparing numbers using mathematical language such as greater than, less than, and equal to.</p> <p>We will also learn about money and time, including recognising coins, counting amounts, as well as learning how to tell the time.</p>	<p>This half term, children will continue to develop confidence in recognising Set 3 sounds in words as they prepare for the phonics screening check. They will also continue to build fluency when reading words ‘at a glance’.</p> <p>Children will practise blending 4 and 5-sound words with increasing fluency and become more confident in reading and spelling red words.</p> <p>In addition, children will further develop their comprehension skills by gaining a greater understanding of the texts they read and answering questions about characters, events, and key details.</p>	<p>We will continue to explore our text <i>Supertato</i> and begin creating our own ‘Beat the Monster’ tales inspired by the story. We will also write an information text all about the characters in <i>Supertato</i>.</p> <p>In addition, we will learn about poetry through the poem <i>Magic Box</i> by Kit Wright.</p>	<p>In Science, we will be learning about plants and their different parts, including roots, stems, leaves, and flowers. We will explore what plants need to grow and how each part helps the plant survive.</p>	<p>In PSHE, we will be learning about living in the wider world and exploring how we can look after each other and the world around us. Children will discuss the importance of kindness, respect, and helping others both at school and in the wider community.</p> <p>We will also learn about how to care for our environment by thinking about ways to reduce waste, recycle, and look after the natural world. Through discussions and activities, children will begin to understand how their actions can make a positive difference to others and the world we live in.</p>

<p>This half term, the children will continue to develop their skills in following instructions when using a Chromebook. They will build confidence using different tools and navigating technology independently.</p> <p>We will also use our Chromebook skills to learn about LEGO builders, following and creating instructions while developing teamwork, problem-solving, and computing skills.</p>	<p>In Art, we will be exploring sculpture and 3D art through our topic <i>Paper Play</i>. Children will experiment with folding, rolling, cutting, and shaping paper to create a range of imaginative sculptures and 3D designs.</p> <p>They will develop their creativity and artistic skills while learning how different techniques can be used to change the shape and structure of paper.</p>	<p>In Geography, we will be exploring the question “<i>What is it like here?</i>” where children will develop their understanding of the local environment.</p> <p>We will also carry out surveys about our playground and use the results to help design an improved version. Children will share ideas, draw maps and plans, and think carefully about how changes could make the playground better for everyone.</p>	<p>This half term in PE, we will use the target skills we have developed through learning net and wall games. We will continue to build on our coordination, accuracy, and control while applying these skills in different activities.</p> <p>We will also focus on developing our teamwork skills, learning how to work together effectively while staying active and enjoying a range of physical challenges.</p>	<p>In Music this half term, our theme is “<i>Animals</i>”.</p> <p>We will explore percussion instruments, creating beats and rhythms to represent different animals and their surroundings.</p>
